The publication will be on the web site each quarter from here on out. If you wish to stop receiving hard copies, one can be E-mail to you.


It is of the utmost importance that we receive this information as soon as posable. If NO response is received from you to the National Secretary we can only assume you do not wish to receive the Can DO.




THE SPIRIT OF THE GREAT FIFTY-EIGHT LIVES ON

Much has been said of warships having a spirit that lives on long after the ship has gone to rest. While not a warship, the spirit of Naval Mobile Construction Battalion (NMCB) 58 lives on long after the battalion had been relegated to the annals of naval history. Recommissioned and having made three deployments during the Vietnam War, NMCB58 is unique among Seabee Battalions. Because NMCB58 deployed only to Vietnam, every battalion member is Vietnam War Veteran. Decommissioning did nothing to dilute the spirit of the greatness; *The Great Fifty-Eight* lives on. *Esprit de corps* and love for their Battalion brothers is what keeps The *Fifty-Eight Seabees* together.

The NMCB 58 Association is dedicated to taking care of its own, and that, they do very well. Recently, one of *Fifty-Eight's* finest Seabees, a combat-wounded veteran, who had lost his entire shoulder, arm and hand to a Viet Cong booby trap learned that his remaining shoulder required a complete reverse shoulder replacement. This would be a traumatic operation for anyone; mobility of the arm is restricted for several weeks during recovery. Combat wounds exacerbated our Seabee's situation.

Members of NMCB 58 Association refused to allow one of their own to be isolated without connectivity outside hospital walls. Most Bluetooth phone devices require pushing a button or flipping a switch to activate a smartphone. Manual manipulation of a devise was not an option; there had to be a better way. Association members researched and located a special phone device that can be magnetically activated without being touched. Once activated, incoming and outgoing calls are accessed by voice command. This no-touch device enables their Seabee to reach out to family and friends in a way that would not have been possible otherwise. In addition to taking care of their shipmates, *The Great Fifty-Eight* continues to reach out to those in need. Since its inception, *The Great Fifty-Eight* Association has contributed more than \$75,000 to 25 military affiliates and community based non-profit organizations, has continued to support the families of those Shipmates lost in Vietnam, and has established its own website. 


