

GROUP EVENT United States Air Force Academy (<https://www.usafa.af.mil>); 0.9 miles/3 minutes (to gate) and 12 miles/15 minutes to Chapel and Cadet quadrant from the Academy Hotel, Colorado Springs; Daily from 0530-2200 hours (Hours are subject to season of year and Military Base Security; FREE to drive (Military ID, Driver's License or picture ID), hike and sight see; Falcon Stadium, Cadet Chapel (estimated construction completion 2023), flight line, scenic pictures.

GROUP EVENT Pikes Peak National Cemetery (<https://www.cem.va.gov/cems/nchp/PikesPeak.asp>); 19 miles/31 minutes from the Academy Hotel, Colorado Springs; OPEN Sunrise to Sunset; No cost; Dedication of Navy Seabee monument by Island X-4, Longmont, CO during the 76th National Navy SVA Convention.

INDIVIDUAL EVENT Cowboy ProRodeo Hall of Fame (<https://www.prorodeohalloffame.com>); 4.6 miles/9 minutes from the Academy Hotel, Colorado Springs; M-SU 0900-1700; Military \$6.00 Adults \$8.00; The ProRodeo Hall of Fame and Museum of the American Cowboy educates the public about rodeo, its history and impact on Western American culture, and provides recognition to rodeo notables of the past and present and serves as an inspiration for the future.

INDIVIDUAL EVENT Garden of the Gods Park (<https://www.gardenofgods.com>); 8.8miles/14 minutes from the Academy Hotel, Colorado Springs; Visitor & Nature Center M-SU 0900-1700, Park 0500-2200; Cost is FREE; Garden of the Gods Park is a registered National Natural Landmark. Imagine dramatic views, 300' towering sandstone rock formations against a backdrop of snow-capped Pikes Peak and brilliant blue skies.

INDIVIDUAL EVENT Manitou Incline (<https://cityofcoloradosprings.aluvii.com/store/...>); 17.3 miles/26 minutes from the Academy Hotel, Colorado Springs; open from 6 AM until 6 PM with **free ADVANCED reservations are required.**; The Manitou Incline was built as a cable car to carry materials to build pipelines on Pikes Peak. After the pipelines were finished, it was turned into a tourist attraction. This is an INTENSE climb.

INDIVIDUAL EVENT Cripple Creek, CO (<https://www.visitcripplecreek.com>); 53.6 miles/72 minutes from the Academy Hotel, Colorado Springs; A historic mining town with gambling, food, entertainment, souvenirs and shopping that is FREE to tour (Cost required to play or purchase entertainment).

INDIVIDUAL EVENT United States Olympic Training Center (<https://www.teamusa.org/about-the-usopc/olympic>); 18.9 miles/18 minutes from the Academy Hotel, Colorado Springs; Out of an abundance of caution, and in an effort to limit potential exposure to the coronavirus (COVID-19), the OPTC Visitor and Team USA Shop are **temporarily closed and tours are unavailable at this time.**; The Colorado Springs Olympic & Paralympic Training Center is able to provide housing, dining, training facilities, recreational facilities and other services for more than 500 athletes and coaches at one time on the complex.
